Cambodia Outreach

Dear Friends,

"We can make our plans, but the Lord determines our steps"
Proverbs 16:9

I worked on our trip to Cambodia for almost a year. God gave us a team of 7 men (with police, military and firefighting experience) and our plan was to train and evangelize police, military and firefighters. However after we had bought our tickets a border war broke out between Cambodia and Thailand.

Steve Hyde, the missionary we partnered with, met us in Cambodia. He introduced us to the governor of the province where we would be working. We met with the governor in Poi Pet, a city of 100,000 on the border with Thailand. The fighting was only about 15 miles from us. The governor ended up telling us that almost all the police, military and firefighters were on the border supporting the war. Therefore we would not be able to work with them.

As we prayed about what God wanted us to do, Steve came up with the idea of ministering in the public schools in Poi Pet. So we decided to do police tactics and fire safety demonstration to the students. We worked in 7 schools and had about 1500 students from 1st grade through high school. We shared testimonies and I preached the gospel to the students. I led them in the sinners prayer and since in their culture they do not make a public response to the gospel, only God knows how many of these precious lives will be saved.

It is hard to describe Cambodia in words. In this Buddhist country, about 5% of the people are believers. The gospel is growing quickly and there are thousands of churches with an average attendance of 40 people.

The governor invited us back so we will plan another trip the beginning of next year to work with police, military and firefighters. Thank you for your prayers and financial support.
